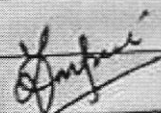

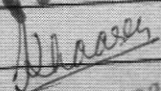
WORLD NO TOBACCO DAY

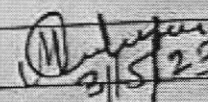

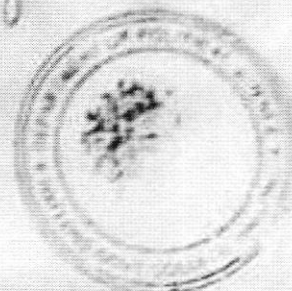

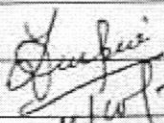

GLOBAL HANDWASHING DAY

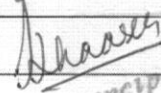
